Purpose of the Scholarship Fund

The CAC will provide selected scholarship candidates with the ability to attend one “Fundamentals of Compressed Air Systems” CAC training course. The purpose of the scholarship is to advance learning about compressed air systems and best practices through the CAC Fundamentals of Compressed Air Systems training program (CAC Fundamentals). It is targeted at new entrants to the industry (e.g., students or others not currently employed or engaged in the operation of compressed air systems).

Eligibility

Any student enrolled in a college, technical school or other secondary education program is eligible to submit an application.

Selection Criteria

The CAC scholarship selection committee will consider applications based upon the following criteria: 1) quality and persuasiveness of the applicant’s one-page statement; and 2) -evidence of being an enrolled student in post-high school technical training program or university. Limit 2 students per institution per year.

The Scholarship fund selection committee

A group comprised of (5) CAC board and committee members will be responsible for review and award of scholarships. Criteria and operating procedures for the fund are described below.

Scholarship Amount and Stipulation

The amount of each scholarship will be enough to pay for one CAC Fundamentals class. Scholarships must be used within one year of the award date.

Oversight of Funds

The CAC Board has established a separate financial account to hold contributions to the fund and will oversee its distribution and management. The fund’s balance and transactions will be made available upon request to any contributor. The CAC Treasurer will be responsible for receipt and distribution of all scholarship funds.

Application Requirements

Applicants shall submit a brief statement (approximately 500 words) expressing why the applicant desires the award and why this education path is of interest to them. The applicant should include contact information for at least two references. Applicants should note potential course locations and dates where the scholarship would be used. Planned trainings are listed on the Calendar page of the CAC web site.

Application Process

Scholarships may be applied for at any time relative to available CAC course offerings. Applicant shall complete the Application Form, included as page-two of this document, and email it to the CAC Training Coordinator, Patricia Vazquez, at “patvazquez@aol.com.”

This application must be submitted a minimum of four weeks prior to course offering to allow for review and processing. Applicants will be notified of award status by email within two weeks of receipt of application by the CAC. Successful applicants will be emailed a notice of Scholarship Award that should be submitted to the Host of the CAC Fundamentals of Compressed Air Systems that they plan to attend. The CAC will reimburse the training host directly for the cost of the student attending the training session.
